To the ninth Interrogatory - That he is aware of nothing further which could prove of any material benefit - to the Complainant, in this cause William H Kemp - a witness of lawful age, also produced, on the part of the Complainant - being duly sworn & examined to the 5th & 7th Interrogatory as aforesaid - deposes & says

To the 5th Interrogatory - That he knows - that the property - mentioned in the exhibits A, B, C, D, E, & that his father David Kemp & John S Kemp conducted the business of stilling & distilling in said property as partners - knows furthermore that the Real Estate in question was purchased & paid for out of the partnership funds. To the seventh Interrogatory That the partnership was indebted at the death of David Kemp That the personal Estate being insufficient for the liquidation of the partnership debts, it is requisite that the Real Estate should be sold, in order to pay the debts there being no other witnesses produced, and neither party desiring for this time for the purpose of obtaining evidence, in the cause, the Commission arose, closed the said Commission and herewith returns the same, under their hands and seal this 28th day of May A.D. 1856.
