and said Grayson Echelberger shall first file with the Clerk of
this Court, his Bond, with approved security in the sum of Twelve
thousand dollars Conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties
as such Trustee, and the course & manner of his proceedings shall be
the same as those prescribed in the Original Decree in this cause.

1856. Whereas by a Decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County,
sitting as a Court of Equity, bearing date on the 16 day of December
1856, and passed in a cause pending in said Court, between Michael F.
Echelberger & others as Complainants, and Elizabeth Echelberger
and others as defendants, being N: 2579 on the Equity-Docket of said
Court, the said Grayson Echelberger, was appointed Trustee to make
Sale of certain Real Estate in said proceedings mentioned.

Now the Condition of the above obligation is such, that if
the above bound Grayson Echelberger, do & shall well & faithfully
discharge the Trust reposed in him by said Decree, or which may
be reposed in him by any future Decree, or Order in the premises, -
then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to be & remain
