 This cause being submitted to the Court, upon
 the Petition of John Smith of Md, the present Trustee, and all other
 of the proceedings in the said case N: 1836 Equity, which was duly
 considered by the Court. It is thereupon this 6: day of February 1856.
 by the Court, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court
 ordered, adjudged and decreed that Grayson Eichelberger be, and he
 is hereby appointed Trustee in this case, in the place and stead
 of the said Joseph Smith, the Original Trustee, deceased, the said
 John Smith of Md, being hereby discharged from his Trust. That said
 Grayson Eichelberger, as such Trustee proceed to complete the unfinished
 trust reposed on said Joseph Smith dec'd by the Decree of the 7th of
 October 1845 &c and it is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed that
 the said Grayson Eichelberger shall file with the Clerk of this Court
 his Bond, executed by himself, and good & approved Security in the
 penalty of Two thousand Dollars. Conditions for the faithful perform
 and of the Trust reposed in him by this Decree, or that may be
 reposed in him by any future Decree and Order in the premises
 and that the said Grayson Eichelberger is hereby fully authorized to
 complete said unfinished Trust, and to all other things in the prem
 ises, to complete said Trust, as may from time to time be ordered by this Court
 necessary to the final settlement of the said estate of Middleton Smith
 dec'd in said case.

 State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the said State
 in the just and full sum of Two thousand Dollars. Current money -
 to be paid to the said State, or its certain attorney, to which payment
 well, and truly to be made, and done, we bind ourselves, and each of
 us, our & each of our, and each of our heirs, executors & adminis-
 trators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our
 seals, and dated this 15th day of March, A.D. 1856.

Whereas by a Decree of the Circuit Court, for Frederick County sitting
 as a Court of Equity, bearing date, on the 6: day of February 1856, and
 passed in a cause pending in said Court, on the petition of John
 Smith of Md, between George Hartman as Complainant & Joseph
 Smith executor of Middleton Smith as defendant being N: 1836,
 on the Equity Docket of said Court, the said Grayson Eichelberger was
 appointed Trustee, in the place and stead of John Smith of Md,
 to carry out, and complete the unfinished trust created by the origi-
 nal Decree passed in said cause now the condition of the above-
 obligation is such - that if the above bound, Grayson Eichelberger
 do, and shall well and faithfully discharge the trust reposed in him
 by said Decree or which may be reposed in him by any future Decree
 or order in the premises, then the above obligation shall be void -
