A. the 27 day of December 1796. to wit:

This Indenture made this Twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord 1796. between Abraham Lancaster of Frederick County & State of Maryland of the one part; and Daniel House of the same place of the other part; Witnesseth - That the said Abraham Lancaster, for & in Consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds good, and lawful money of Maryland to him in hand paid by the said Daniel House, the receipt whereof the said Abraham Lancaster doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof & therefrom every part, and part thereof doth fully, clearly & absolutely acquit exonerate, and discharge the said Daniel House, his heirs, executors & administrators, & assigns, hath given, granted, bargained, and sold aliened released, enfeoffed and Confirmed, and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell, alien released, enfeoff, and Confirmed, unto the said Daniel House, his heirs & assigns, the following part of a tract of Land called "Ware" lying in Frederick County - aforesaid Beginning at the end of the 35th line of The Resurvey on Long Bottom Surveyed for William House & running S 68° W 48 ps. then S 18° E 44 ps then S. 2° E 12 ps then S 20 1/2° E 10 ps then at 65° W 75 ps. then N 25° E 74 ps. then E 12 ps then N 63° E 12 ps. then by
