 2549 Equity. which your Complainants pray may be taken as a part of
 this their Supplemental Bill your Complainants state that they
 make Thomas Boyet a party defendant erroneously. he having
 no interest in said land. and that Andrew House. one of the said
 heirs at Law. has applied for. and taken the benefit of the Insolvent
 law - and Joseph Harrison of Frederick County. having been appointed
 trustee as well appears by Exhibit N. 1. And your Com-
 plainants also state that the Interest. and Estate of William
 House. another heir of said Daniel House has been sold to Wash-
 ington Starbough. and to John Keafawer as well appears by
 exhibits N. 2 & 3. Your Complainants further state that John Kea-
 fawer has since died. and that his interests in said estate has de-
 volved on his children to wit. William Keafawer. Lewis H. Keafawer.
 Ann who married Fitts. and Elizabeth M Keafawer. your Com-
 plainants pray your Honor for leave to amend said Bill by stri-
 king out the names of Thomas Boyet. made defendant. in the origi-
 nal Bill. and by making Joseph Harrison. Trustee of Andrew
 House. and Washington Starbough William Keafawer. Lewis H
 Keafawer William Fitts and Ann R. Fitts his wife & Elizabeth M Kea-
 fawer. children & heirs at law of John Keafawer (d. 2) purchasers of
 the Interest of William House. parties defendants & to order Subpoenas
 to issue to the Sheriff of Frederick County commanding him to summon
 said parties to appear in this Court. by a certain day. and then & there
 answer the Original & Supplemental Bill. and show cause if any they have
 why a decree should not be passed as prayed for in said Original Bill &
 you Complainants well ever pray &c. Wm. J. Roff. Att. for Com.
 In the Circuit Court for Frederick County - In Equity Ordered by the Court
 this 6th day of March. 1856. That the Original Bill be amended & Subpoenas
