It is the end therefore - That the said Joseph Kuhn David Kuhn, Leander Kuhn and John Kuhn the infant heirs of said dec'd and Sarah Kuhn the widow of said dec'd, may full, true, direct & perfect answers make to all, & singular the Charges and matters aforesaid as fully in every respect, as if the same were here again repeated and they thereunto particularly interrogated. May it please your Honor to adjudge order & decree, that the Real Estate of which the said Joseph Kuhn late of said County, died the owner, and seized be sold by a Trustee to be appointed for that purpose, for the benefit of the said heirs at law & widow, and may it please your Honor to extend to your orators, and oratrix all such other and further relief in the premises, as the nature of the Case may require, and as to your Honor may seem meet. May it please your Honor to grant, unto your orators & oratrix, the State of Maryland out of Dulp^d to be directed to the said Joseph Kuhn, David Kuhn, Leander Kuhn & John Kuhn the Infant heirs, and Sarah Kuhn the widow - thereby commanding them, and each of them, to be & appear before your Honor, in your Honorable Court, on some day to be specified, and then & there to answer, all, and singular the premises, aforesaid, and to stand to perform and obey such order, directed & decree therein, as to your Honor may seem meet and your orators &c. will ever pray &c.

At the request of Joseph Kuhn the following deed was Recorded October 8. 1807. - This Indenture - Made this 1st day of August in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven Between Abram Rosenow, and Elizabeth Rosenow his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Joseph Kuhn of the County and State aforesaid of the other part: Witnesseth That the said Abram Rosenow, and Elizabeth his wife - for & in Consideration of the sum of one thousand and fifty dollars Current money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Kuhn, on or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Abram Rosenow & Elizabeth his wife do hereby acknowledge, and from every part and parcel thereof do hereby acquit, exonerate, and discharge, the said Joseph Kuhn, his heirs & assigns, forever - they the said Abram Rosenow, & Elizabeth Rosenow his wife, have given, granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do give grant bargain, sell also release, enfeoff, and confirm -
