This indenture made this 28th day of March 1829, between Neal McCallian of the one part, of Frederick County & State of Maryland of the one part, and Henry McHenry of County & State aforesaid, Witnesses, that the said Neal McCallian for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & fifty five dollars current money of the State of Maryland, to him in hand paid by the said Henry McHenry, on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Neal McCallian doth hereby acknowledge, and from every part & parcel thereof doth hereby acquit, exonerate and discharge the said Henry McHenry his heirs & assigns forever, the said Neal McCallian hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, infeoffed & confirmed and doth hereby grant, bargain sell, alien infeoff & confirm, unto the said Henry McHenry his heirs and assigns forever. All the following part of a tract of land, it being part of the Mountain tract of lot Number ten, situate & lying in the County & State aforesaid. Beginning for the same at a stone planted at the end of the fourth line of George Gummersons sixty acre part of said lot No 10. being the end of three perches on the 17th line of said lot No 10 & running thence by & with the outlines thereof, North 35° E 95¹/₂ ps. to a stone planted, thence N 83° west 47¹/₂ ps. to a stone planted the end of the first line of a certain Jacob Harps land, and running thence South 98° W. 83¹/₂ ps. to a stone planted S 70¹/₂° E 33¹/₄ ps. to the first mentioned place of beginning, containing 20³/₄ acres of land, more or less. together with all & singular the privileges, advantages & appurtenances therunto belonging in remainder, rents, issues & profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof, and all the right and estate of Neal McCallian of in and to the same. To Have and to hold the said lands & premises, with its rights, members & appurtenances to the said Henry McHenry his heirs and assigns forever, to his & their only proper use & behoof, and to & for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever: And the said Neal McCallian, for himself, his heirs, executors & administrators hath agreed & doth hereby covenant and agree, to & with the said Henry McHenry to warrant and forever defend hereafter, the land with the appurtenances to him the said Henry McHenry his heirs and assigns forever, and against all persons claiming by from or under him, them or any of them. In witness whereof the said Neal McCallian hath set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year first within written.
