The above cause standing ready for a hearing and being submitted - The Bill - Answers - Exhibits, depositions and all other proceedings were by the court read and considered.

Decree

It is thereupon this 12<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year 1855, by Madison Nelson, Circuit Judge for the Third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity, ordered adjudged and decreed, that the real estate whereof Henry M<sup>c</sup>Henry late of Frederick County deceased, did seized and possessed be sold for the payment of his debts, and that John Rouzer of Frederick County be and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make said sale, and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows - He shall first file with the Clerk of this Court a bond to the State of Maryland to be executed by himself and one or more sureties in the penalty of Twenty five hundred dollars, to be approved by this court or the Clerk thereof, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this decree or which may be reposed in him by any future decree or order in the premises - He shall then proceed to make sale of said real estate - having first given at least three weeks public notice by advertisement inserted in one or more of the newspapers published in Frederick County of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, which terms shall be one half of the purchase money in Cash on the day of sale - The residue in two or three months from the day of sale the purchaser or purchasers giving his or her
