Petition

To the Honorable M. Nelson Judge of
the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity,
The petition of John S. Motter of the County of Lewis and State
of Missouri respectfully shews to your Honor, that heretofore
to wit, on the 14th day of November 1854, he was appointed by a Decree
of your Honorable Court, Trustee, to sell and dispose of the real estate
mentioned in No 2581 Equity a cause then pending in this Court, & that
he duly performed the duties imposed by such decree, sold said prop-
erty and reported all his action to this Court which was duly ratified
and confirmed thereby, that several of the children of your Petitioner
became entitled to a share of said sale, as shown by the Auditors Re-
port therein made & ratified and that George R. Motter, William H.
Motter, Joseph B. Motter, and Cecelia A. Motter are infants, the three for-
mer under the age of twenty one, and the latter under the age of eighteen
years, that said infants are non-residents of the State of Maryland,
being and residing with your Petitioner in the State of Missouri, and that
they nor either of them have any guardian residing in the State of Maryland,
Your Petitioner further shews that he has been duly qualified as Guardian
of his said infant children according to the laws of the State of Missouri,
and that he has there given good and sufficient Bond & Security for
the faithful performance of his Trust, and that he has the custody of
the persons of his said infant children, as their Guardian & Parent,
He further states that he holds as Trustee appointed by the aforesaid
Decree the sum of two hundred and fifty five dollars and ninety one
and one seventh cents (\$255. $\frac{1}{7}$) belonging to each of his said wards as shown
by the Auditors Report filed in said cause, and that he is desirous of
releasing the sureties on his Trustee's Bond filed in this Court and having
the authority and direction of this Court to pay over as Trustee, to himself as
Guardian the amount specified above as shown to be due and thus release
said sureties, He files with this Petition a copy of his appointment and qual-
ification as Guardian, and the Bond & Security so given as aforesaid, duly
authenticated, together with the approval of the Tribunal by whom such security
was taken, as to the sufficiency of such security, all things being considered, He
therefore prays your Honor to pass an order, ordering and directing him as
Trustee, to pay, transfer and deliver to himself as Guardian said portion of the
proceeds of said sale so due his said wards as aforesaid, in such time and in
like manner as provided by the Laws of Maryland in the cases where said
