Kline, an infant under the age of twenty one years and now residing in Frederick County, And that the said James Kline died intestate seized and possessed of the following parts of tracts of land, situated in Frederick County, Maryland called "Klines Good Will" "Klines Old Fields" "Simply Ridge" "Meadow Land" "Weaver last Renewed" "The third time of Asking" containing forty five and three fourths acres and ten perches of land, all which well fully appear by the deed from Paul Kline to the said James Kline, a true copy of which deed is herewith exhibited marked Exhibit No 1, which with all other exhibits your petitioner prays may be taken as a part of this her petition, And your petitioner further sheweth that it will be to the interest and advantage of the said Sarah Ann E.
