Dated the eleventh day of December, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty five.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Violetta Hoskinson & Mary P Hoskinson, or either of them, their or either of their heirs, Executors or administrators, do and shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the above named Ariana M^e Elfresh, her executors, administrators or Assigns, the just and full sum of two thousand dollars, Current Money, with interest for the same from the thirteenth day of December, eighteen hundred & forty five, on or before the thirteenth day of December eighteen hundred and forty six, then this obligation shall be void and of none effect, else of full force and virtue in law.
