To the Hon. W. Nelson, Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity. I have charged the Trustee in this case with the amount of sale funds reported & then allowed the Commissions Costs, Expenses & and the two mortgage claims filed. Then, as the lands sold consisted of two separate tracts, one of which belonged to Mrs. Mary P. Coramption in fee & in her own right and was chargeable with a claim for which it was mortgaged by herself & her husband and the other belonged to her life & on her death to her children and was encumbered with a mortgage executed by Violetta Hoostkinson by whom the said land was devised as aforesaid, I charged the gross proceeds of the sale of the two tracts with their respective proportions of the Costs, Commissions & and the mortgage claims with which they were respectively chargeable & then audited the balance of the one fund to Mrs. Mary P. Coramption & the other in trust for her benefit during her life & on her death to her children, in accordance with the provisions of the will of said Violetta Grayson, March 28th 1857.
