At the request of Calvin Page the following Mortgage was recorded October 16th 1855

This Indenture made this eleventh day of October in the year eighteen hundred and fifty six between George Beckenbaugh of Frederick County Maryland of the one part & Calvin Page of said County & State of the other part, whereas the said George Beckenbaugh is indebted to said Calvin Page in the sum of six hundred & sixty eight dollars & ninety four cents by note dated the first of October 1855 & payable on the first day of April 1856 & the better to secure the payment thereof is willing to execute these presents. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said George Beckenbaugh for & in consideration of the premises & also of the sum of One dollar Current Money by the said Calvin Page to him in hand paid at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell unto the said Calvin Page his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, all & singular the goods, furniture & household stuff herein after particularly mentioned, appraised or referred to, to wit: two settles, four arm Chairs, one Rocking Chair, one Table, one Desk, one Mirror, two Maps, one dozen Windsor Chairs, one eight day Clock, two Coal Stoves, one bank (all which articles are now in the Office & Gentlemen's sitting room in the Hotel now kept by said Geo. Beckenbaugh.) also the following articles in the Parlor adjoining the Office: to wit: One Carpet, one Mahogany sofa, one Marble Top Table, two cane seat Rocking Chairs, one dozen Cane seat Windsor Chairs, one Air Tight Stove & pipe, one fland lamp, two Venetian Blinds, one gilt frame View of Frederick, also the following articles in the Ladies Ordinary, to wit: One large Mirror, one set of Mahogany dining Tables, one other dining Table, one Carpet, four Oil Cloth window blinds, one Lounge, one Mahogany side Board, ten Windsor Chairs, one Stove; also the following articles in the dining room: to wit, two Safes, twenty eight Windsor Chairs, one large Egg Stove & pipe, one set of Dining Ware, one set of Breakfast Ware, five Castors, four Venetian Blinds, also the following articles in the Kitchen & Wash House to wit, two Cooking Stoves & apparatus, one eight day Mantel Clock, one twenty four hour Clock, ten dozen Knives & forks, one wardrobe, one tin ditto, one large Coffee urn, six wash tubs, two Iron Kettles, also the following articles in Room No 11 (even) to wit, two double Beds, one single Bed, two wash stands, Bowls & Pitchers, one pair of Brass Andersons, four Windsor Chairs, one Mirror, Matting, also the following
