 Deed is recorded, the 30th day of Nov 1840

This Indenture made this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and forty between Henry M. Jamison and Mary A.
 Jamison his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and
 Lloyd Dorsey of Baltimore County in said State of the other part, witnesseth that
 the said Henry M. Jamison and Mary A. Jamison his wife for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of four thousand two hundred and fifty dollars Current Money
 of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Lloyd Dorsey before the
 sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Henry M. and
 Mary A. his wife do hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold, aliened,
 enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,
 alien, enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Lloyd Dorsey and his heirs and
 assigns, all the North front of the lot of ground numbered one hundred and
 nine lying and being in Frederick-Town in the County and State aforesaid the
 same front being on this street North of Patrick Street and extending back for the
 full width of said lot fifty four feet to that time of the said piece of ground which
 runs from Market Street parallel with third street to the North East corner of that
 part of lot number one hundred and ten now held by George Balthell and running
 thence across lot Number one hundred and nine to lot number one hundred and
 eight so as to include to the said Lloyd Dorsey the profession of lot number one hun-
 dred and nine, also part of lot one hundred and ten fronting on Market Street fifty
 four feet and fronting on third Street sixty two feet more or less being the same two
 pieces or parcels of ground which were heretofore conveyed to the said Henry M. Jamison
 by David D. Schaeffer as by reference to his deed recorded in Liber H. S. 174 folios
 495 and 496 one of the Land Records of the County aforesaid will more fully appear, Together
 with all & singular the buildings, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and
 and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title and interest
 whatsoever of them the said Henry M. Jamison and Mary his wife, both at law and Equity
 of, in, to and out of, the said pieces or parcels of ground and premises hereby bargained and
 sold or meant, mentioned or intended hereby to be and every and every part and parcel
 thereof. To Have and to hold the said pieces or parcels of ground so as aforesaid
 together with the buildings, appurtenances and all and singular the other premises
 hereby bargained and sold or meant, mentioned and intended hereby so to be and every
 part and parcel thereof with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Lloyd
 Dorsey and to his heirs and assigns forever, and to and for no other use intent and
 purpose whatsoever, And the said Henry M. Jamison and Mary A. his wife
 for themselves, their heirs, Executors and Administrators do hereby covenant, grant,
 promise and agree to & with the said Lloyd Dorsey and heirs, Executors and ad-
 ministrators or assigns that they the said Henry M. and Mary A. and their heirs the
