Frederick Town Savings Institution vs Joseph Brocke & Others

N<sup>o</sup> 2683 Equity, In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, July Term 1856.

The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the real estate of Ignatius Brocke, dec<sup>d</sup> for payment of debts owing by said Brocke at the time of his death. The Bill states that said Ignatius Brocke at the time of his death was indebted to the complainant in the sum of ninety five dollars & to divers other persons in large sums of money; That said Brocke died in April 1855, after having duly made his last will, whereby he devised his property to his wife for life, after her death to be sold & after payment of two pecuniary legacies, to be distributed among his children equally, & appeared Jacob Beilich his executor, that the personal estate is not sufficient to pay debts, that said Brocke left a widow Ann Maria Brocke & seven children; to wit Joseph Brocke, Catharine intermarried with Joseph Wisendorf, John Brocke, William Brocke, Peter Brocke, Theodore Brocke, & Charles Brocke; all of whom are adults except Charles who is a minor, that Joseph lives in Alleghany County Maryland, John lives in the State of Michigan, Catharine & her husband in the State of Illinois the rest in Frederick County Maryland; that the real estate left by said Ignatius Brocke consists of a house & lot in Frederick-Town, Maryland, the Bill prays for subpoena, an order of publication, decree for sale & general relief. It is thereupon adjudged & ordered that the Complainant by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick-Town, once a week for one month before the first day of October 1856 give notice to the said absent defendants of the object & substance of this Bill & warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1857 to answer the premises & shew Cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed,
