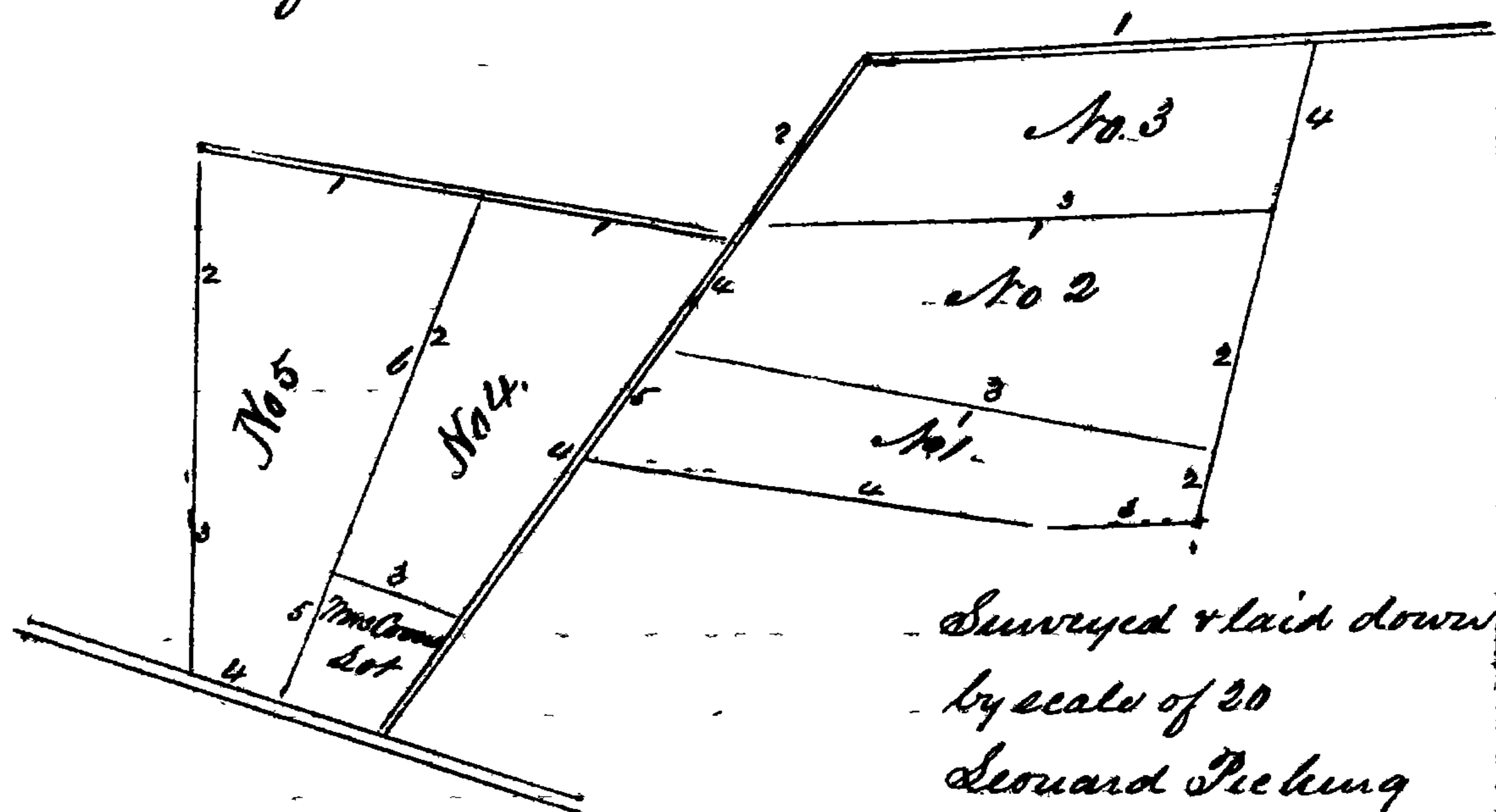
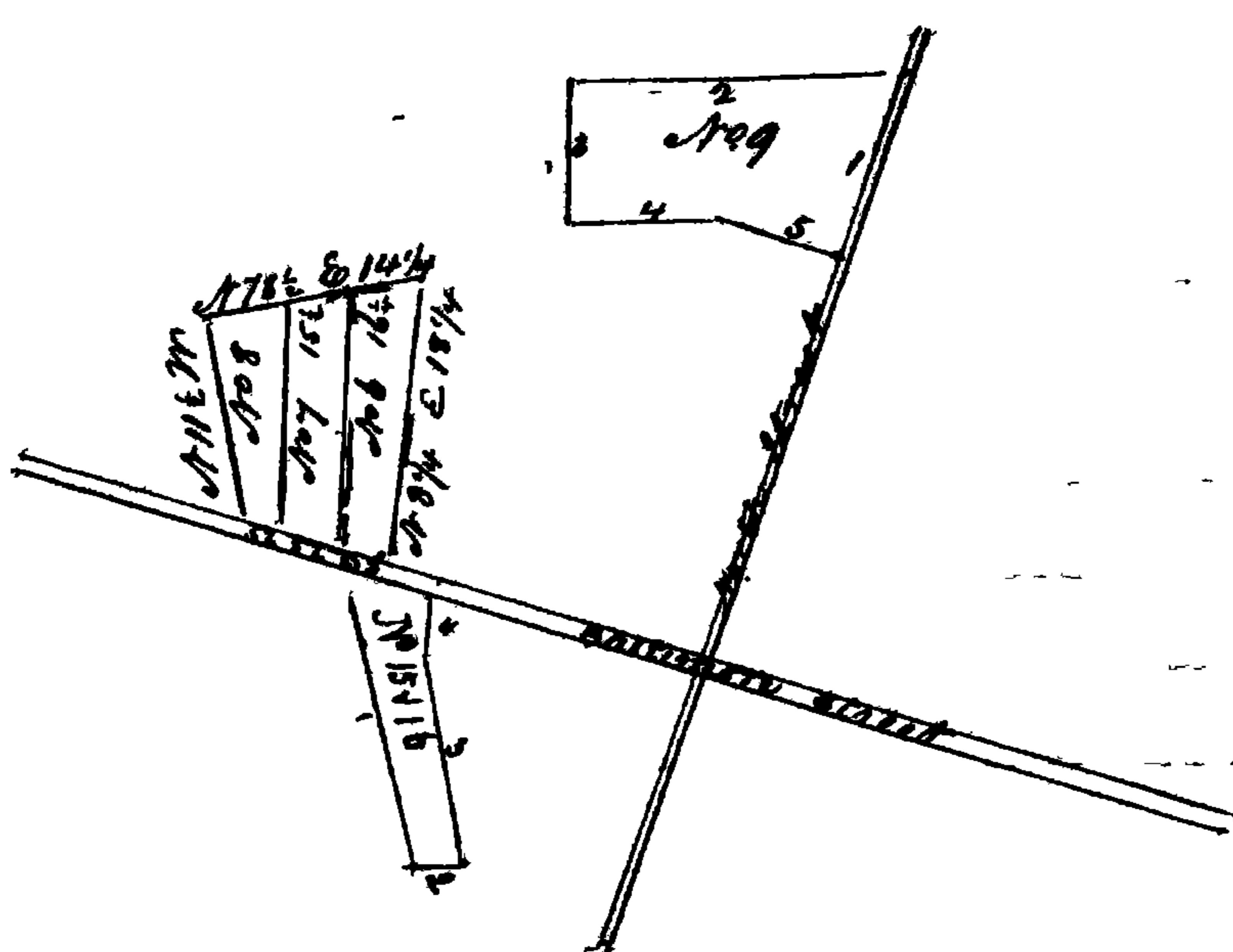


Lots of the Estate of David Luckensland dec^d

Courses and distances of the above Lots surveyed for John Gumbert, Trustee of the Estate of David Luckensland late of Frederick County, dec^d. Lots No. 1, 2 & 3 is part of a tract of land called the Resurvey on Stony Corner, conveyed by Jacob Trorer to said Luckensland dated June 9th 1825. Beginning for Lot No. 1 at a stone planted at the end of the 4th line of the whole Lot & with it reversed South 87 degrees West 11 3/4 ps to Stone North 80 1/2^o W 35 3/4 ps N 34 E 10 1/4 ps S 78 1/2 E 43 3/4 ps S 16 W 6 ps to beginning containing 2 3/4 Acres, Lot No. 2. Beginning at the end of 3rd line of Lot No. 1 and running N 34 E 12 ps N 88 E 41 7/10 ps South 14 W 20 3/10 ps N 78 1/2 W 43 3/4 ps to B. Containing 4 Acres, Lot No. 3. Beginning at the end of the 1st line of Lot No. 2 & running with Church road N 34 E 16 ps N 87 E 35 1/2 ps South 14 degrees W 13 7/10 ps to Lot No. 2 & with it S 88 W 41 7/10 to beginning containing 3 1/2 Acres, Lots No. 4 & 5 is part of the same Tract conveyed by Christian Weller to David Luckensland by deed bearing date on the 15th day of April 1826 Beginning for Lot No. 4 at a stone planted on the West side of said Church road at the end of the 1st line of the whole Lot and running thence N 82 W 21 1/2 ps S 20 1/2 W 32 3/10 ps S 70 E 12 ps to said road & with it N 34 E 37 7/10 perches containing 3 3/4 Acres, Lot 5. Beginning at the end of the 1st line of Lot No. 4 & running N 82 W 22 7/10 ps to Rouzer's Land yard Lot & with it according to original bearing South 25 perches, S 5 1/2 E 16 3/10 ps to street & with it S 71 1/2 E 7 7/10 ps North 18 1/2 E 12 3/10 ps N 20 1/2 E 32 ps to beginning containing 3 7/8 Acres, Lots No. 6, 7 and 8 are Lots, situate and lying on the North side of Balt. Street adjoining the Lot of Ideary Rouzer on the East & North sides, & the Lots of Solomon Eyles on the West No. 6 fronts the Main Street 53 feet runs back by Course N 6 1/2 degrees East 16 1/4 ps No 7 & 8 each fronts 52 feet runs back by division between them North 5^o E. 15 1/2 ps No 9 is a Lot, situate and lying on the West side of North Street in Mechanics town as conveyed by Christian Weller to David Luckensland on the 15th of April 1826.
