To the end that the defendants therein named may answer the several matters & things herebefore charged as fully & particularly as if they were therein interrogated, & the real estate of the said deceased, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose may be sold for payment of the claims of your Orator & other unsatisfied creditors & that your Orator may have such further or other relief in the premises as Equity may require. May it please your Honor to grant to your Orator the writ of Subpoena against David Keller, Elizabeth Keller Melinda Atkins, Solomon and Sarah Shaff Lydia, Caspandra, Elizabeth the younger, John; Martin Robert, James, & Charles Keller commanding them to appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises, & abide by & perform such decree as may be passed therein, & as in duty bound &c.
