The object of the Bill filed in the present case is to obtain a decree for the partition or in case the same cannot be divided, for a sale of the real estate whereof Samuel Marken died seized and possessed.

The Bill states that Samuel Marken died intestate in the year eighteen hundred and fifty four. Seized in fee of a Tract of Land situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, called "Good Luck" containing ninety four acres, one rood, and twenty six perches of land, that he left a widow named Margaret, and the following children John Marken who married Cathanne Recker, Jacob Marken who married Rebecca Garnet, a daughter Cathanne now wife of John Hoover of S. Henry Marken who married Eliza a daughter Mahala now wife of John D. Doble, Wesley Marken married to Sarah E. Haines, and Elias Marken, that all the children and heirs at law of Samuel Marken reside in Frederick County except John Marken who resides without the State of Maryland, and Jacob Marken and Rebecca his wife who reside in the State of Indiana, that all the heirs at law are of full age except Elias Marken who is an infant under the age of twenty one years. The Bill further states the land is susceptible of division, and if not susceptible of partition, that the same ought to be sold and the proceeds divided among the parties entitled.
