 No 1 Lot

Beginning for the outlines of No 1 Lot at the beginning of the whole Tract and running with the first line thereof $N 41^{\circ} 25' 10''$ to the beginning of the Widows dower, then with said dower 11 Courses and distances, viz. $N 21^{\circ} E 22 \frac{1}{2} p$, $N 64^{\circ} 10' W 8 p$, $N 35^{\circ} E 6 \frac{1}{2} p$, South $56^{\circ} E 10 p$, $S 29^{\circ} E 4 p$, $S 58^{\circ} E 4 p$, $S 22^{\circ} W 8 p$, $N 60^{\circ} W 15 p$, $N 35^{\circ} E 14 p$, $N 45^{\circ} W 10 p$, $N 29^{\circ} E 27 p$ then with Lot No 3 one Course & distance $S 41^{\circ} E 16 p$ to a course of the Church Lot then with said Church Lot two Courses and distances, $S 28^{\circ} W 9 p$, $S 59^{\circ} E 8 \frac{1}{2} p$ to the beginning of the 15th line of the whole tract then with the 15th & 16th lines $S 11^{\circ} E 7 \frac{1}{2} p$ to the end of the 1st line of Lot No 2 then with said Lot No 2 reversely $N 75^{\circ} W 30 \frac{1}{2} p$ to the beginning containing 15 Acres, 1 rood & 17 perches of Land, more or less,

No 2 Lot

Beginning for the outlines of Lot No 2 at the beginning of the whole tract and running thence $S 75^{\circ} E 30 \frac{1}{2} p$ to intersect the 16th line of the whole tract at the end of 9 perches from the end of said 16th line, then with the outlines of the whole tract four Courses, viz. $S 11^{\circ} E 9 p$ to a stone, $S 16^{\circ} 20' W 16 \frac{1}{2} p$ to a stone, $N 72^{\circ} W 34 p$ to a stone $N 14 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 22 p$ to the place of the beginning containing 4 Acres, 3 roods and 29 square perches of Land, more or less.

No 3 Lot

Beginning for the outlines of Lot No 3 at the end of the 13th line of the whole tract the same being a stone standing on the East side of the Public Road near the Church and running thence $N 33^{\circ} 2' W 3 \frac{3}{4} p$ to a stone being a corner of the Church Lot, then with it 1 Course and distance $N 62^{\circ} W 4 \frac{1}{2} p$, then $N 41^{\circ} W 16 p$ to the end of the 5th line of the Widows Dower then with said dower reversely three Courses and distances, viz. $N 43^{\circ} W 19 \frac{1}{2} p$, $S 43^{\circ} W 32 p$, $N 70^{\circ} W 18 p$, to intersect the 2nd line of the whole tract at the end of $24 \frac{3}{4} p$ then with the outlines of the whole tract four Courses and distances, viz. $N 34 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 40 \frac{3}{8} p$ to a stone, $S 1 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 34 \frac{3}{4} p$ to a stone, $N 36^{\circ} E 46 \frac{3}{4} p$ to a stone; $N 36^{\circ} E 19 \frac{3}{4} p$ to a stake standing near a red oak tree and on the East side of the Boettersburg road then with said road and Lot No 4 $S 7 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 29 \frac{1}{2} p$ to a stake, $S 2 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 34 \frac{4}{100} p$ to the place of beginning containing 8 Acres, 1 rood & 20 perches of Land more or less.

No 4 Lot

Beginning for the outlines of No 4 Lot at the end of the 13th line of the whole tract the same being a stone standing on the East side of the Public Road and near the Church, and running thence with the Public Road and Lot No 3 two Courses and distances, viz. $N 2 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 34 \frac{44}{100} p$ to a stone $N 7 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 29 \frac{1}{2} p$ to a stake against a red oak tree intersecting the 5th line of the whole tract at the end of $19 \frac{1}{4} p$ and thence with said 5th line $N 36^{\circ} E 58 p$ to a stone, then with Lot No 5 three Courses and distances, viz. $S 11^{\circ} E 29 \frac{3}{4} p$ to a stake; $S 57^{\circ} E 28 p$ to a stake, $S 31 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 21 \frac{1}{4} p$ to intersect the 11th line of the whole tract at the end of 30 perches; then with the outlines of the whole tract $S 62^{\circ} W 68 \frac{1}{2} p$ to a stone; $S 20^{\circ} E 14 \frac{55}{100} p$ to a stone, $S 76^{\circ} W 15 \frac{1}{2} p$ to the place of beginning, containing 24 Acres, 1 rood & 30 perches of Land, more or less

No 5 Lot

Beginning for the outlines of Lot No 5 at a stone standing at the beginning of the 11th line of the whole tract and running thence with said 11th line $S 62^{\circ} W 30 p$ to a stake, being the beginning of the 7th line of Lot No 4 then with Lot No 4, three Courses and distances reversely $N 31 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 21 \frac{1}{4} p$ to a stake;
