Fischer by his certain other promisory note bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1852 ninety days after the date thereof promised to pay to "The President, Directors and Company of the Farmers Bank of Maryland" one thousand dollars for value received negotiable & payable at the Frederick-Town Branch Bank, and whereas the said George J. Fischer by his certain bill obligatory bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1850 & payable six months after the date thereof owes and stands indebted to Henry K. Elfish in the sum of one thousand dollars for value received with interest from the date thereof (excepting so far as the said interest has been paid thereon) and whereas the said Michael Keefer, Alexander B. Hanson & Jacob Markell as securities for said George J. Fischer stand equally bound and liable with the said George J. Fischer in all the aforementioned promisory notes and in said bill obligatory all of which are duly stamped as required by law, and whereas the said George J. Fischer is desirous to indemnify, secure and save harmless the said Michael Keefer, Alexander B. Hanson & Jacob Markell from all loss by reason of their liability as securities for said George J. Fischer on said bill obligatory & promisory notes as aforesaid or on any that may from time to time be given by way of renewal thereof. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said George J. Fischer and Isabella Fischer his wife, for & in consideration of the premises & of the further sum of five dollars current money in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given, granted, bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed & confirmed and by these presents do give, grant, bargain & sell, alien, enfeoff, release, convey and confirm unto the said Michael Keefer, Alexander B. Hanson & Jacob Markell their heirs & assigns all their property of every nature & description whatsoever, real, personal and mixed heretofore conveyed to said Jacob Markell, Michael Keefer, Alexander B. Hanson by deed of mortgage bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1849 & duly recorded in Liber N. B. T. N. 9 folios 543<sup>d</sup> one of the land records of Frederick County, to which reference is hereby made for a full & particular description of the estate, real, personal and mixed hereby conveyed or intended so to be. To Have & to hold all the estate real, personal & mixed with all the buildings, privileges, profits & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Alexander B. Hanson, Jacob Markell and Michael Keefer, their executors, administrators, heirs and assigns forever to & for the only proper use & behoof of the said Michael Keefer, Jacob Markell & Alexander B. Hanson their executors, administrators, heirs and assigns forever to & for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever, provided always & it is the true intent and meaning of these presents & of the parties thereto that if the said George J. Fischer do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid the aforesaid sum of money as herein before recited with the legal interest due thereon, and do and shall well & truly indemnify and save harmless the said Michael Keefer Jacob Markell and Alexander B. Hanson from all and every loss by reason of their liability as securities as herein before recited, then and in that event these presents and every matter & thing herein contained shall cease & be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
