To my son John Williard & his heirs forever. I give, devise & bequeath the farm on which he now resides, containing about one hundred acres. Also my Tanyard & all appurtenances thereto belonging. Also my blacksmith shop & the lots of ground attached thereto, now in the occupancy of John Erwin. Also the two houses & lots on the south side of the street in Jefferson, the one now occupied by the widow Little & the other occupied by Mrs Senega, the whole of the above devises to my said son John to be subject of course to the life estate of one third thereof above given to my wife. To my son Henry Williard & his heirs forever, I give, devise & bequeath all the rest & residue of my real estate in Frederick County, subject of course, to the life estate of one third thereof above given to my wife, To my son Henry Williard I give & bequeath my negro slave Jerry; and at the death of my wife, my female slave Sarah. To my daughter Susannah, I give & bequeath my negro slave Mary. Should my negro man Peter be living at my death, it is my will that he remain with my wife, to aid & assist her, after her death, it is my will that he be supported out of my estate. Subject to the foregoing devises & to my wife's life estate in one third thereof. I give & bequeath to my sons John & Henry to be equally divided between them, all the rest of my personal property whatsoever. To my son Philip Williard I give & bequeath the sum of Six hundred dollars, to be paid, one half thereof by my son John & one half by my son Henry; and in the following manner, one fourth thereof at the end of four years from my death & the residue in three equal Annual payments thereafter. To my son George J Williard I give & bequeath One thousand dollars, to be paid, one half by my son John & one half by my son Henry. one fourth thereof, at the end of four years from my death, and the residue in three equal annual payments thereafter. To my daughter Ann Eliza I give & bequeath One thousand dollars, to be paid, one half by my son John & one half by my son Henry, One fourth thereof at the end of four years from my death & the residue in three equal annual payments thereafter. Having given to my daughter Susannah my negro Mary, valued by me at 120^l. I give & bequeath to my said daughter Susannah, Eight hundred & eighty dollars, to be paid, one half by my son John & one half by my son Henry, one fourth at the end of four years from my death & the residue in three equal annual payments thereafter. Having advanced to my daughter Elizabeth Ramsburg four hundred dollars, I give & bequeath to her the sum of Six hundred dollars, to be paid one half by my son John & one half by my son Henry, one fourth thereof at the end of four years from my death & the residue in three equal annual payments thereafter. Having advanced to my daughter Mary Weaver four hundred dollars, I give & bequeath to her Six hundred dollars, to be paid, one half by my son John & one half by my son Henry, one fourth to be paid at the end of four years after my death, and the residue in three equal annual payments thereafter. To my daughter Catharine Erwin I give & bequeath thirty six dollars per Annum, from the end of four years after my death, whilst she remains childless, should she have a child, I give & bequeath to her my said daughter the sum of Six hundred dollars, to be paid
