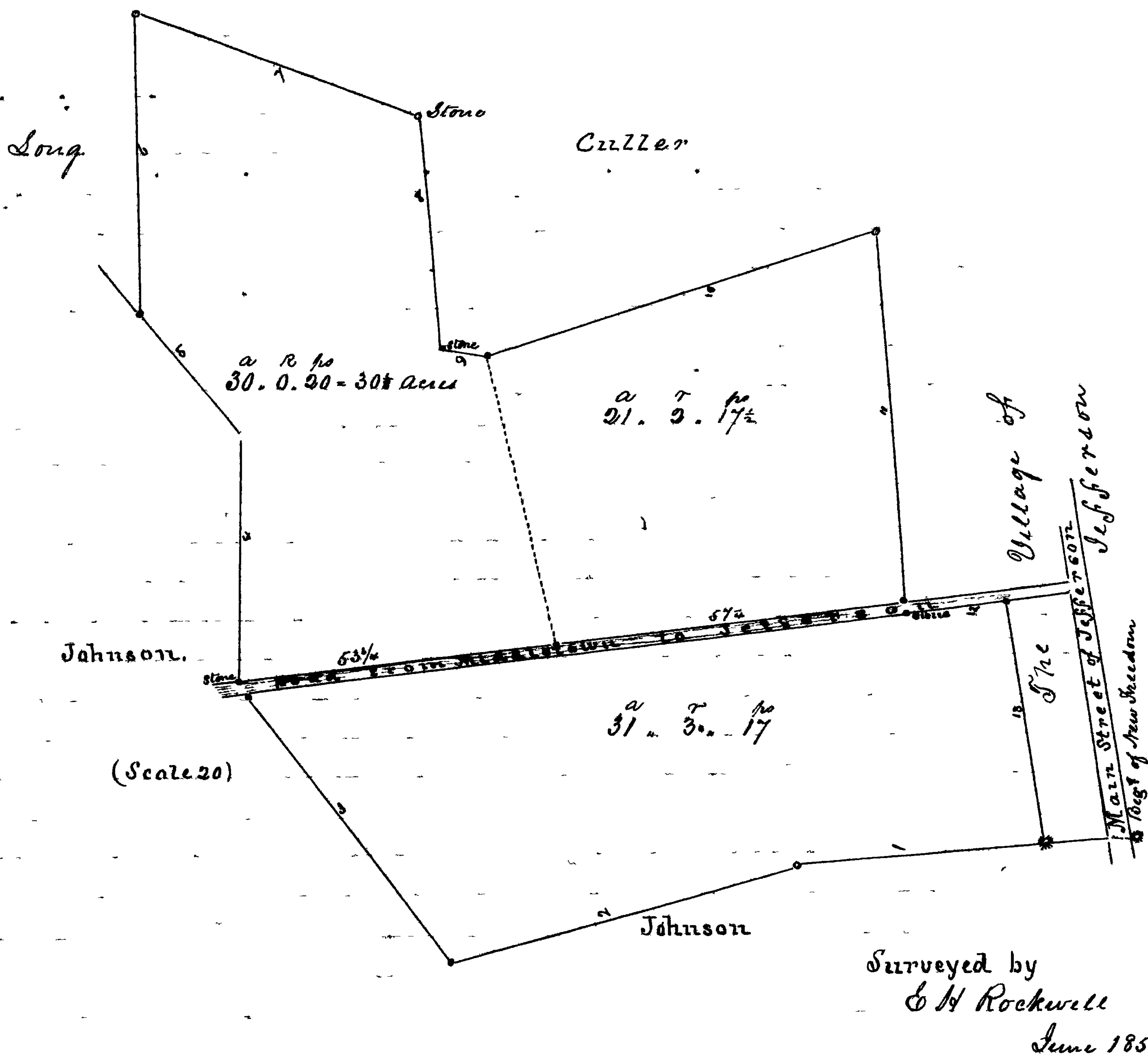

Part of "New Freedom" part of "The Recovery on Melliss Invention" re. lying directly north of
the village of Jefferson in Frederick County. Beginning at the end of 15 1/2 perches on the 1st
line of "New Freedom" it being at the N. W. corner of Jefferson, and running thence with
the line of lot. Tho^s Johnson's farm two lines viz; 1 N 5° 11' 41 1/2 ps to a stone, 2 N 16° 11' 60 ps
to a stone, 3 N 53° 6 58 ps to a stone on the east side of the road leading from Jefferson to
Middletown, thence 4 East 42 1/2 ps, 5 N 52° 6 26 ps, thence 6 N 88 1/2° 6 49 1/2 ps to a stone, 7
S 20 1/2° 10 50 ps to a stone, 8 S 84 1/2° 11 38 1/2 ps to a stone, 9 S 8° 11' 8 ps, 10 S 17 1/2° 6 67 1/2 ps to a stone,
11 S 86° 11' 6 1/2 ps to the east side of the road aforesaid, thence S 86° 11' 1 1/2 ps to a stone on the
west side of the road aforesaid, thence with the west side of the road, 12 S 7° 6 16 1/2 ps to
the north east corner of lot No 11 of said town, thence with a straight line to the
beginning, containing eighty three and a half acres & fifteen perches.
