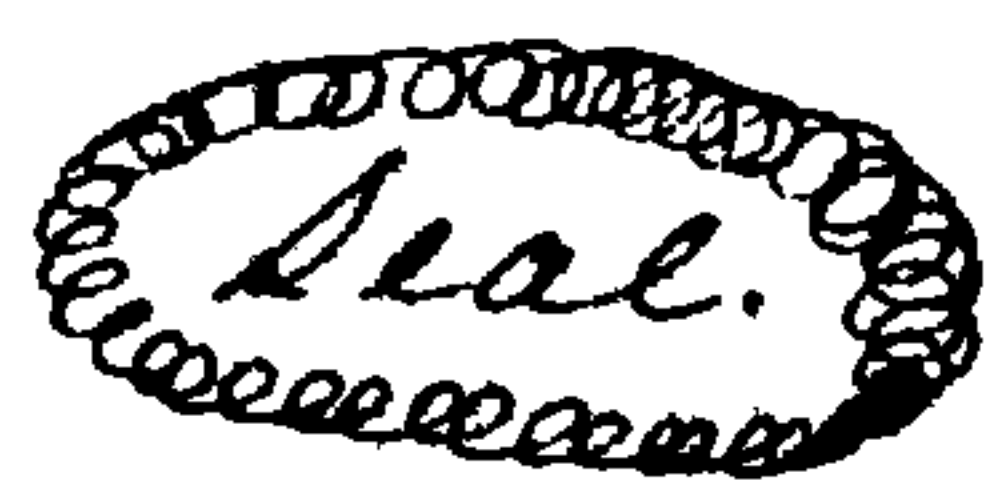

Hereof fail you not, as you will answer the contrary at your peril. Witness the Honorable Madison Stelow, Judge of our said Court, the 6th day of July 1857.

The Answer of John Keafawer and William Campbell of the City of Baltimore, to the Bill of Complaint of John W Ross, filed in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

These defendants admit that Joseph Cartzendafer executed to them the Mortgage exhibited in Complainants Bill, and that the mortgage debt being reduced by payments, they assigned the balance due thereon, amounting to Three thousand seven hundred and thirty two dollars & seventy six cents, to Benjamin F Newcomer and Samuel Stonebraker, as stated in said Bill of Complaint - and these defendants state that they have no further interest in said mortgage or in the debt secured thereby, & pray hence to be dismissed

The Answer of Benjamin F Newcomer and Samuel Stonebraker of the City of Baltimore, to the Bill of Complaint of John W Ross filed in the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity, against themselves and others

These defendants for answer to said Bill - answer and say that they admit to be true as charged in said bill, that Joseph Cartzendafer did execute the mortgage referred to in said bill, to John Keafawer & William Campbell, and that said Cartzendafer made sundry payments thereon, and that on the tenth day of September 1857, there being due on said mortgage the sum of 3732 \$ & 76 c, the said Keafawer & Campbell by an assignment in writing under their hands & seals, assigned said mortgage, and the said balance due thereon to your defendants, which said balance is still owing and unpaid - These defendants further admit the execution of the mortgage by said Cartzendafer to said John W Ross as stated in said bill - These defendants further say, that they have no personal knowledge of the mortgages executed by said Cartzendafer subsequent to the mortgage now held by your defendants, but have been informed, and so admit, that the said subsequent mortgages have been executed by said Joseph Cartzendafer as stated and set forth in the said bill of Complaint - These defendants are willing and hereby consent that a decree may be passed for a sale of the said mortgaged premises, and that the proceeds of sale
