



I will they shall receive by way of advance before a final distribution shall take place, if there remain a sufficiency of personal at the decease of my beloved wife, should not so much personal then remain, in that case they shall receive the above devised sum out of the real estate before a final dividend shall be made, having thus far disposed of part of my estate in order to balance accounts between my legal representatives, it remains to dispose of the balance, concerning which it is my will, that my daughter Mary wife of John Sifford, my son Henry and my son William shall have the whole of my estate not before disposed of, real and personal, share and share alike, and in every respect equal share giving my daughter Mary the wife of John Sifford one third, my son Henry one third, and my son William one third respectively and their heirs. And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Elizabeth to be the Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four.


