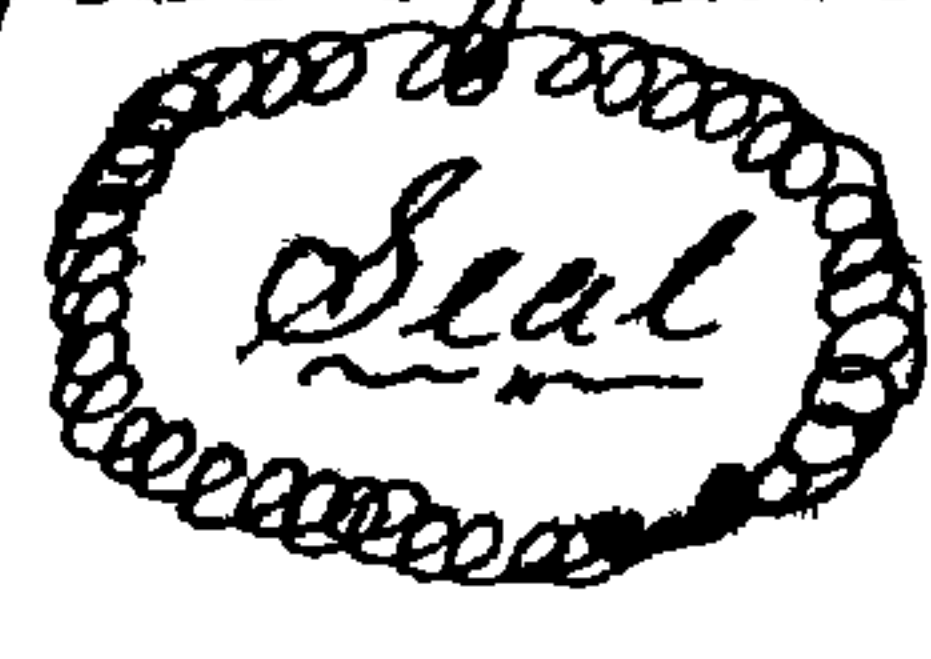

This Indenture, made this 30th day of March in the year of our Lord 1837, between William J. Seabrooks and Maria C. Seabrooks his wife, of Adams County and State of Pennsylvania of the one part, and Frederick Eichelberger of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said William J. Seabrooks and Maria C. Seabrooks, for & in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eighty five dollars current money of the United States, to them in hand paid, by the said Frederick Eichelberger, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said William J. Seabrooks and Maria C. Seabrooks do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, infeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, infeoff and confirm, unto the said Frederick Eichelberger his heirs and assigns forever; All that lot or portion of ground and premises, situate, lying and being in Creagers town in the County and state aforesaid, known and distinguished on the plan of said town, by number eighty, - together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining. - To Have and to Hold the said lot or portion of ground and premises, above described, and every part and parcel thereof, with their and every of their appurtenances, unto the said Frederick Eichelberger his heirs and assigns forever, to his & their only proper use and behoof, and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever; and they the said William J. Seabrooks and Maria C. Seabrooks, for themselves and their heirs, executors & administrators, doth hereby covenant, grant, promise and agree, to & with the said Frederick Eichelberger his heirs executors, administrators or assigns, that they the said William J. Seabrooks & Maria C. Seabrooks and their heirs, the said lot or portion of ground and premises hereby granted, bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to him the said Frederick Eichelberger his heirs and assigns, against them the said William J. Seabrooks and Maria C. Seabrooks and their heirs, and against all and every person or persons whatsoever, claiming, or to claim any right, title or
