Bill

To the Honble M Nelson, Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting  
 in Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Elizabeth Delauter of Frederick County humbly  
 shows, that heretofore, to wit - on the third day of February in the year 1854 a cer-  
 tain Silghman H Young and Mary Young his wife, being indebted to your Oratrix  
 in the sum of One hundred and fourteen dollars current money, and intending  
 to secure the payment thereof unto your Oratrix, did by their deed of that date  
 convey to your oratrix and her heirs, a certain lot lying in said county and  
 particularly described in said deed, to which said deed there is a condition an-  
 nexed, that it be void on payment by the said Silghman H Young and Mary Young  
 to your oratrix of the aforesaid sum of money with interest thereon, from the  
 third day of February 1854, on or before the third day of April 1854, as by a copy  
 of said deed filed herewith as part of this Bill, will more fully appear marked  
 Exhibit A - and your Oratrix charges that after the execution of said deed, the  
 said Silghman H Young and Mary Young departed this life, leaving one child  
 Margaret E Young, who is an infant under twenty one years of age, and her  
 at law - Your Oratrix further charges that no part of said sum of money  
 or the interest accruing thereon has been paid to her by said Silghman H Young  
 and Mary Young or either of them in their life time, nor has any one for them,
