This Indenture made this 3rd day of February 1854, between Tilghman H Young and Mary Young his wife, of Frederick County & State of Maryland of the one part, and Elizabeth Delauter of the county and state aforesaid of the other part. Whereas the said Tilghman H Young and Mary his wife, by their note duly executed, bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of February 1854, stands bound unto the said Elizabeth Delauter in the sum of one hundred & fourteen dollars current money, with legal interest for the same, on or before the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April next, ensuing the date of these presents Now this Indenture witnesseth, that the said Tilghman H Young and Mary his wife, in consideration of the said debt or sum of money owing to the said Elizabeth Delauter as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof with interest to the said Elizabeth Delauter her executors, administrators or assigns, and also in consideration of the further sum of one dollar current money of the United States to them the said Tilghman H Young and Mary Young his wife, by the said Elizabeth Delauter, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the grantee, bargained sold released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant sell release alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Elizabeth Delauter her heirs and assigns - all that lot or parcel of ground, situate, lying & being at the south end of Brewers Alley in Frederick town in the county and state aforesaid, distinguished as part of Lot number seven - it being part of lot number seven of the two lots numbers seven and eight (7 & 8) in a deed from Isaac P Suman and wife, to Mary Young, dated the 28th day of October 1853, as by reference to said deed will more fully and at large appear - Beginning for said part of lot number seven hereby intended to be conveyed at the south west corner of said lot number seven, as embraced in the deed above recited, in one general outline, and thence along said Alley northwardly 41 feet to the intersection of the lot belonging to Tobias Haller, thence east to a stake sixty eight feet along said lot thence south 33 feet to a stake, and thence west along the Alley leading from South Market street 42 feet 7 inches to the place of beginning - together with all and singular the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining. - To Have and to Hold the said lot or parcel of ground and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said

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
