At the execution of the annexed commission, issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a court of equity - and to me directed, and empowering me to examine witnesses in the cause depending in the said court, between Elizabeth Delauter as Complainant and Margaret E Young as defendant - I, George K Shellman the Commissioner therein named, having taken the oath annexed to the said Commission, and dispensed with a Clerk, did, pursuant to previous notice, at my office, in Frederick town, on the 9th day of June A. D. 1856, proceed to take the following depositions, in the presence of the Solicitor for the Complainant - to wit. -

Michael Piomett - a witness of competent age, produced on the part of the Complainant - being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commission by the Complainant's Solicitor, & herewith returned, deposes and says -

To the 1st Interrogatory. - That he does know the parties to this suit. -

To 2nd Int. That he did know Silghman H Young and Mary Young his wife - they are dead - Silghman H. died sometime last fall - and Mary his wife sometime during the last winter

To 3rd Int. - That they left, as deponent understands, at the death of said Mary Young, two children, of whom one, an infant, has since died, at the age of a few months - and the other named Margaret E Young an infant under the age of twenty one years, is still living, and resides in Frederick County Maryland

To the 4th Int. - Deponent looks at Exhibit A - and says that he does know the real estate therein conveyed to the Complainant - and that Silghman H. and Mary Young died possessed of said real estate. -

And the Commissioner returns herewith, and as a part of the testimony the said paper marked Exhibit A. - There being no other witnesses to be examined, and no further time for the production of witnesses being desired - the Commission closed the said Commission, and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal this 9th day of June A. D. 1856.

This cause standing ready for hearing, and being submitted without argument, the proceedings were read and considered - It is thereupon this 9th day of July A D 1856 by Madison Nelson Judge of said court & by the authority of said court adjudged ordered and decreed, that unless the sum of One hundred and fourteen dollars & interest, with costs of this suit be paid before 18th July next, that the mortgaged premises in these proceedings mentioned be sold - that Elizabeth Delauter of Frederick County be appointed trustee to make such sale, and that the manner of proceeding shall be, she shall first file in this Court a bond to the State of Maryland with sureties approved by the Clerk in the penalty of five hundred dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed by this decree or
