Mortgage is recorded November 13<sup>th</sup> 1849

This Indenture made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord 1849 -  
Exhibit A between Philip McLaughran of Frederick County in the state of Maryland  
To of the one part and Hugh McAleer of the County and state aforesaid of the  
Bill other part. Whereas the said Philip McLaughran by his note of hand bearing  
equal date with these presents payable six months after date with legal  
interest on the same (with the understanding between the parties that  
the payment of the principal is not to be demanded under three years from  
date - the interest however to be paid annually) stands bound unto the  
said Hugh McAleer in the full sum of \$762.60<sup>cts</sup> said note being on stamped  
paper And whereas the said Philip McLaughran in order to save him the  
said Hugh McAleer harmless and indemnified & free from all loss hath agreed  
to execute these presents. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Philip  
McLaughran in consideration of the premises and for & in consideration of one  
dollar current money to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery  
of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Philip McLaughran doth  
herby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliene released infeoffed  
and confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell aliene release confirm  
& confirm unto him the said Hugh McAleer his heirs & assigns forever All  
those Lots pieces or parcels of ground and premises lying & being at the  
Village called "The Point of Rocks" in Frederick County state aforesaid to  
wit all that Lot designated on the plat of the Point of Rocks as Lot number  
110 and which said Lot was on the 30 day of April 1835 deeded by Charles  
Johnson surviving Executor of the last will and testament of Roger Johnson  
deceased to the said Philip McLaughran reference being had to Liber 765 No. 3.  
folios 420 & 421 one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid will more  
fully and at large appear also all that Lot piece or parcel of land which was  
by deed dated the 28 day of July 1847 conveyed by Elias L Delashmuth Collector  
of Frederick County aforesaid to the said Philip McLaughran reference being  
had to the Land Records of the County aforesaid in Liber 775 No. 5 folios 296 &  
will more fully appear and also all those lots designated number 8 & number 9  
which were purchased of the properly authorized agent for the sale of the real  
estate of George Snouffer late of Frederick County aforesaid deceased by the
