 This Indenture made this 12 day of August in the year of our Lord 1857 between John L B Moines and Martha R his wife of Frederick County in the state of Maryland of the one part and Charles Worthington of I of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of \$3323 current money by the said Charles Worthington of I to the said John L B Moines in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said John L B Moines and Martha R his wife have bargained & sold aliened and enfeoffed and by these presents do give grant bargain & sell alien & enfeoff release convey and confirm unto the said Charles Worthington of I his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and claim at Law in Equity which they the said John L B Moines and Martha R his wife have of and to all the real estate and lands of which the late
