






Bond Know all men by these presents that we Henry Carter Milton Carter Charles

 jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this  
 eighth day of February in the year 1858. Whereas by a decree of the Circuit  
 Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity bearing date on the fourth  
 day of February 1858 and passed in a cause in said Court wherein Henry  
 Carter and Margaret E. Carter his wife and Milton Carter are complainants  
 and Jeremiah Baile and Elizabeth Baile his wife and others are defen-  
 dants the above bound Henry Carter and Milton Carter have been appointed  
 trustees to make sale of certain real estate in the proceedings in said  
 cause mentioned. Now the condition of the above obligation is such  
 that if the above bound Henry Carter and Milton Carter do and  
 shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in them by said  
 decree or that may be reposed in them by any future decree or order in
