We the subscribers Commissioners appointed in the annexed commission do hereby certify that after having taken the oath as required by the said commission from annexed before Edward Steyer Esquire of the Justice of the peace and for Frederick County and due notice having been given by the commissioners after their qualification as aforesaid to all the parties concerned of the time and place appointed for the execution of the said commission did meet on the premises on the 14th day of February last and then and there carefully viewed and examined the estate in the said commission mentioned and caused the same to be surveyed and located by Dana Bowles who was selected as the surveyor for that purpose as will appear by the plat herunto annexed and carefully laid down on them printed to lay off the widows down being part of a tract of land called the Barrell.
