I Test D Mc Ginn Register of Wills for Baltimore County, Jacob Morys do make and publish this as a second Codicil to my foregoing last will and testament Whereas at the instance and request of my daughter Julianna Cole I purchased the lands and premises situate and lying in Baltimore County which were conveyed to me by John Philpot and wife and Elizabeth Philpot by Indenture bearing date the first day of May last past & recorded among the land records of Baltimore County Court therefore I do hereby revoke annul and abrogate the devise of \$10,000 made in trust by my said will for the benefit of my said daughter Julianna Cole and in lieu thereof I do hereby devise the same lands and premises with the improvements and appurtenances free and clear of all mortgages liens mortgages which are to be paid by me or out of my estate unto my Sons Samuel Morys and my Son in Law James Williams and Joshua Dulves and the survivors and survivor of them and the heirs executors and administrators of the survivor in trust for the benefit of my said daughter Julianna during her natural life in the same way and after her decease to descend in the same manner as is mentioned in my said foregoing Will and Testament in relation to the said sum of \$10,000 I hereby set apart for the benefit of my said daughter Julianna and the benefit of her children and descendants and so forth Provided always however that if the cost of said lands and the other charges against my said daughter Julianna in my account book marked A shall exceed the amount of the share of my estate set apart for or devised to my other daughters respectively such excess shall be refunded by my said daughter Julianna and until so refunded shall with the interest thereon be a lien upon the said lands and premises.
