This Indenture made this 23 day March 1848 between George Engelbrecht and Ann M Engelbrecht his wife of Frederick County in the state of Maryland of the one part and Joshua S Dulles and James Williams of the city of Baltimore and Samuel Moyer of the state of Virginia Trustees as hereinafter mentioned of the other part Witnesseth whereas Jacob Moyer late of the city of Baltimore by his last will testament gave and bequeathed to the said Joshua S Dulles James Williams and Samuel Moyer certain money in special trust as fully set forth in said Will for the benefit of his daughter Emily Augusta Moyer now Emily Augusta Robertson wife of James H Robertson of Frederick County aforesaid and whereas the said Joshua S Dulles James Williams and Samuel Moyer in pursuance of the power vested in them by said last will and testament and in part execution of the trust therein and thereby created and as by them represented with a part of the trust money held by them for the benefit of the said Emily Augusta Robertson have agreed to purchase the property hereinafter particularly mentioned described and conveyed and the said parties of the first part having agreed to sell to the said parties of the second part the said property for the sum of \$6700 and the whole of said sum of

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
