In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity February term 1858 The foregoing Petition and affidavits having been read and considered and the Court having examined and being satisfied with the sufficiency of the bond and the regularity of the appointment of Alexander H Young as the guardian of his infant children Catharine Alice Young & Mary Ann Young by the proper & legal tribunal in the County of Washington in the District of Columbia It is therefore this 31<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year 1858 ordered adjudged and decreed by Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity that Thomas Johnson and Bradley J Johnson Trustees in A<sup>o</sup> 1818 Equity pay over to Alexander H Young - guardian as aforesaid the above sum of \$122.90 cents and due to their deceased Mother by and under the name of Lerena host which said sum they now hold as trustees in the above case.

Know all men by these presents that we Alexander H Young Joseph Lyons and Jonathan J Walker are held and firmly bound unto the United States of America in the just and full sum of \$20,000 current money of the said United States to be paid to the said United States their certain attorney or assigns to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs executors and administrators in and for the whole jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 28<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year 1854. The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Alexander H Young as guardian to Catharine A Young Mary A Young and Albert Young Infant children of said Alexander H Young of Washington County shall faithfully account with the Orphans Court of Washington County as directed by Law for the management of the property and estate of the children under his care and shall also deliver up the said property agreeably to the order of the said Court or the directions of Law and shall in all respects perform the duty of guardian to the said Catharine A & Mary A and Albert Young according to law then the above obligation will cease it shall otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law
