Hon. Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity. - The report of Basil Delashmutt & Thomas R. Jarboe, trustees in the above case, shows that after giving bond with approved security and at least three weeks notice by advertisements in the Citizen and Examiner, two newspapers published in Frederick, in the Lancaster Intelligencer a newspaper published in Lancaster - in the State of Pennsylvania and by handbills extensively circulated, of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, they did pursuant to said notice attend on the premises on Saturday the 14th day of February 1863, at 10 o'clock A.M. and there sold at public sale to Michael W. Fout the tracts of land designated on the plat filed herewith as Exhibit B, D. to this report as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 containing three hundred and seventy eight acres two rods and eleven perches of land at and for the sum of thirty dollars per acre, as will appear by the acknowledgment of purchase filed herewith as Exhibit M, W, F. to this report, signed by said Michael W. Fout, being part of the real estate described in the bill, exhibits and proceedings in this case, the purchase money for said tract amounting to eleven thousand three hundred and fifty seven dollars and six cents.

Your trustees then sold to Grafton Durrall the farm known as the Manor farm, being the same described and located on said plat as Lot No 3. Containing one hundred and eighty eight acres, two rods and thirty six square perches of land at and for the sum of sixty five dollars and twenty five cents per acre, the same being the land described in Exhibit No. 1. in this case, except fifteen acres which were cut off and five acres, more or less, added thereto, the whole purchase money for said tract amounting to twelve thousand three hundred and fourteen dollars and thirty cents and your trustees file herewith as Exhibit G, D. the acknowledgment of said purchase signed and executed by said Grafton Durrall.

Your trustees then sold to Lycurgus Eagle the tract known as the Lower or the Three Spring Mill Farm designated on said plat as Lot No 4. receiving of said tract half an acre more or less, said tract hereby sold containing by Survey and including the part reserved, one hundred and fifty eight acres two rods and twelve perches of land, the whole of said purchase money amounting, at twenty six dollars per acre for which it was sold to four thousand one hundred and twenty two dollars and ninety five cents and the said Lycurgus Eagle has signed an acknowledgment of purchase which is filed herewith as exhibit L. E. to this report

Your trustees then sold to John S. W. Jarboe the mountain lot specified and described on the plat filed herewith as Exhibit S. R. J. to this report containing twenty eight and one quarter acres of land at and for the price of twenty dollars and eighty cents per acre the purchase
