Exhibit No 1. Six months after date I promise to pay to John M. Kemp or order one hundred dollars for value rec^d with interest from date, Witness my hand and Seal this 5th day of July 1860. \$100. Wm. Newton

Exhibit No 2. Six months after date I promise to pay to John M. Kemp or order one hundred dollars with legal interest for value rec^d - Witness my hand and Seal this Seventh day of August 1860, \$100. Wm. Newton

Exhibit No 3. I William Newton of Jefferson County State of Virginia, being now indebted to John M. Kemp of Frederick County State of Maryland in the sum of two hundred dollars by note dated July 5th 1860 for one hundred dollars, and also one dated this 7th day of August 1860, for one hundred dollars, in consideration thereof do hereby bargain and sell to the said John M. Kemp, the following property, consisting of house and lot, No 20, in Knoxville Frederick County State of Maryland, provided, that if I the said William Newton shall pay to the said John M. Kemp, the said sums with legal interest thereon, on or before the 7th day of February 1861 next, then these presents shall be void, Witness my hand and Seal this Seventh day of August 1860. Wm. Newton

State of Maryland Frederick County, to wit, I hereby certify that on this 7th day of August 1860 before me the subscriber a justice of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Frederick County personally appeared William Newton and acknowledged the foregoing Bill of Sale to be his act, for the purpose therein contained, James Reely J.P.

And also personally appeared the aforesaid John M. Kemp and made oath in due form of Law, that the foregoing Bill of Sale is true bona fide consideration, James Reely J.P.

William Newton } The object of this Suit is to procure a decree for a sale of certain real estate in Frederick County State of Maryland, mortgaged by a certain William Newton to John M. Kemp. The Bill states that on the 5th day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty a certain William Newton of Jefferson County State of Virginia was indebted unto the complainant by his single Bill of the date aforesaid for one hundred dollars payable six months after date with interest from date and also by his other single bill dated the Seventh day of August eighteen hundred and Sixty, for one hundred dollars payable six months after date with interest from date - and to secure the payment of said single bills did on the Seventh day of August eighteen hundred and Sixty, execute his deed of mortgage to the said John M. Kemp of a house and lot No 20 in Knoxville Frederick County State of Maryland, with a condition attached that it be void if payment should be made on or before the Seventh day of December Eighteen hundred and Sixty one all of which will appear by reference to said bill of Complaint and its Exhibits, which single bills and interest are still due and unpaid to complainant, and that the said William Newton is now a resident of Jefferson County State of Virginia. It is thereupon this 31st day of July 1862 ordered that the complainant causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published at Frederick, once in each of four successive weeks before the sixth day of September Eighteen hundred and Sixty two, give notice to the said absent defendant of the object and substance of this bill and warn him to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before the ninth day of December Eighteen hundred and Sixty two to answer the premises and show cause if any he has.
