To the Honorable the Judges of Frederick County Court sitting as a Court of Equity, The petition of David Barr and Christina Barr both of Washington County respectfully sheweth that Caspar Mantz late of Frederick County being seized and possessed in his lifetime of a considerable real and personal estate lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid, did once about the 29th day of August in the year 1832 duly make and execute his last will and testament, a copy of which is herewith exhibited marked No 1, and which your petitioners pray may be taken and considered by your Honours as a part of this their petition, that the said Caspar Mantz on or about the month of October in the year 1839 died without having revoked or in any manner altered the said will, that in and by said will the said testator did among other things, devise and bequeathed to John H. McElfresh, his heirs or assigns for the purposes, uses and trusts
