Know all men by these presents, that we George Schley of Washington County, Frederick A. Schley, Lloyd Dorsey and William Bradley Tyler of Frederick County, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the sum of Sixty thousand dollars, lawful money, to be paid to the said State or its certain attorney, to which payment, well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, Sealed with our Seals and dated this Seventh day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty four. Whereas the said George Schley was by a decree of Frederick County Court sitting as a Court of Equity, passed in cause number 1782 on the docket of said Court, appointed trustee for the purposes set forth in said decree, as by reference to the same will more fully appear. Now the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the said George Schley shall faithfully discharge the trust reposed in him by said decree, then the above obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
