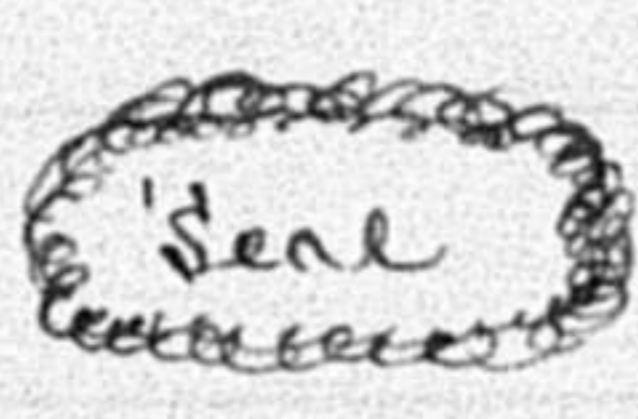

Trustee's Report of Sales

The twenty first report of George Schley trustee, appointed by the decree in this cause, respectfully sheweth that, by the Will of Caspar Mantz dec^d: filed as an exhibit in the above cause, all the real estate devised thereby in trust for Mrs. Christina Barr, was directed to be sold by the trustee, after the death of said Christina, and the proceeds arising therefrom to be equally divided among the children and grand children of said Christina, that might then be living share and share alike, and in the event of any one or more of said children having died before sale of said real estate, in such case the children of such child or children, should be entitled to the same share, that the mother or father would have been entitled to, if living. - That it was further provided in and by said will, that no sale of the real estate therein and thereby devised should be made, until the youngest child of said Christina should have arrived at full age. That, by a special report of your trustee filed March 12 7862 the death of the "cestui qui trust,"
