To the Honourable Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity. - The bill of Complaint of Joshua Motter and Lewis M. Motter of Frederick County respectfully shows that heretofore, to wit, on the 28th day of March in the year 1842 William Welty, John S. Welty, Elias Welty, Mary A. Welty, Sarah Welty, Catharine Welty and Susanna Welty were indebted to your Orator Joshua, by their joint and several single bill, bearing date the day and year aforesaid and payable on or before the first day of October 1842 with interest from the date thereof, in the sum of three hundred and seventy one dollars and fifty four cents, as will fully appear by said single bill herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1, which with all other exhibits your Orator pray may be taken and considered as a part of this bill of Complaint as if here inserted in words and figures. Your Orator further show that Caspar Welty, William Welty, John S. Welty and Elias Welty were on the said 28th day of March 1842 indebted -
