This Indenture made this 28th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty two, between William Welty, John S. Welty, Elias Welty, Mary Welty Sarah Welty, Catharine Welty and Susan Welty of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Joshua Matter of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Whereas the said party of the first part by their note or obligation duly executed bearing date with these presents stands bound unto the said Joshua Matter his Executors, administrators and assigns in the sum of three hundred seventy one dollars and fifty four cents current money with legal interest for the same on or before the first day of October next ensuing the date of these presents as by the said note or obligation may more fully appear, and whereas Casper Welty, William Welty, John S. Welty and Elias Welty being indebted to Joshua Matter, Isaac Matter and Lewis M. Matter Executors of said Lewis Matter dec^d and having at the suit of said Executors on the 24th day of October 1837 confessed a judgment in Frederick County Court in the sum of four hundred sixty five dollars and ninety three cents with interest from the third day of February 1835 and costs as will be more fully seen by reference to No 192 in the original docket to October Court 1837 and for the better securing the said note or obligation and judgment and the sum of monies mentioned therein, doth agree to execute these presents, Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the above recited premises and the further sum of five dollars current money to them the said party of the first part by the said Joshua Matter in hand well and truly paid at or before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof of the said William Welty, John S.
