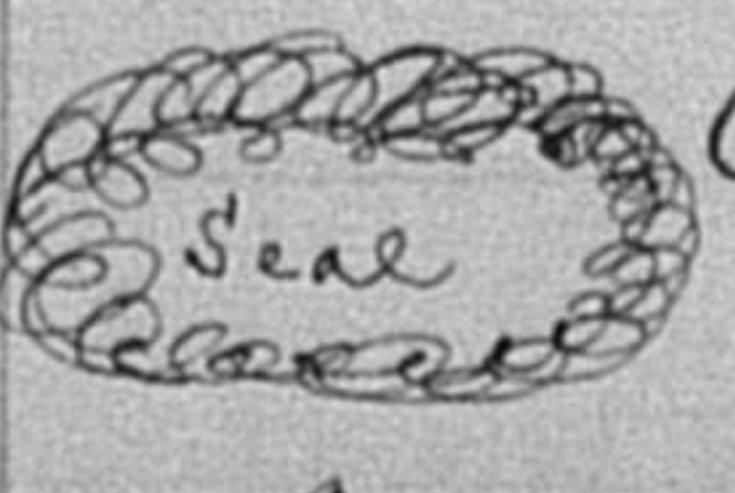
At the request of William J. Ross the following Trust Deed was recorded May 15th 1861 -
This Deed made this 13th day of May in the year 1861. - Whereas Bradley J. Johnson is seized and possessed of considerable property in the State of Maryland which far exceeds all his debts and liabilities, certain and contingent, and whereas he is desirous of making some settlement on his wife Jane C. Johnson, which may provide for her, and whereas after all & every kind of debt and liability is provided for his house and real estate in Frederick City will be left together with considerable amounts of Stocks and other Choses in action, therefore in consideration of the love and affection which he bears his said wife, he Bradley J. Johnson hereby grants and gives, bargains and sells to William J. Ross of Frederick City, all that house & lot of ground now occupied by him at the corner of Record and Second Street, Frederick City, - opposite D. Waters, which was conveyed to him, as to the house by Barbara Robertson's deed and as to the lot by Edward Shriver's deed, together with all my household and office furniture and books, I have and to hold the same in trust for the benefit of my wife Jane C. Johnson.

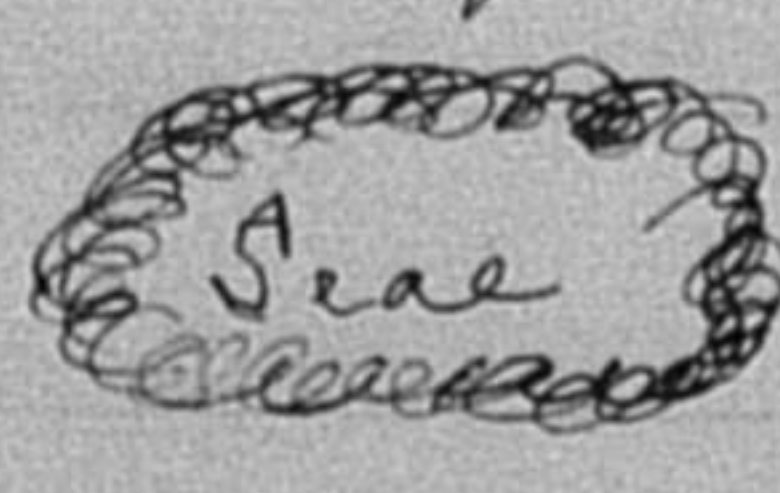
