The petition of Grayson Eichelberger respectfully sheweth to your Honor that on the 4th day of April 1862 a decree was passed by your Honor in the above case, on the bill filed by Barbara Robertson, for the sale of the real estate therein described for the purposes set forth in said proceedings and that your petitioner was appointed the trustee to make such sale - that said trustee has made sale of said property and reported the sale to your Honor, which sale & report has been duly ratified by your Honor and the case referred to the auditor for distribution, all of which will appear by the proceedings in the above entitled case, which your petitioner prays may be taken as a part of this petition as if here inserted. - Your petitioner further states that on the 18th day of August 1862, he sued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County a writ of attachment against the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of said Bradley J. Johnson to satisfy a debt therein specified and that said writ of attachment was laid by the Sheriff of said County, among other things upon the right, title and interest of said Bradley J.
