to wit: Joseph Farguhar a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainant,
being duly affirmed and Examined to interrogatories, filed with the Commissioner by
the Complainant and herewith returned, deposes and says,

To the 1st Interrogatory, That he is acquainted with all the parties to this Suit and has
known all of them since their several births - is the father of three of the dependants and
the uncle of the other three, -

To the 2^d Interrogatory, That they are all infants under the age of twenty one years,

To the 3^d Interrogatory, That he is acquainted with the real estate of which John Farguhar
died seized and possessed - looks at the papers shown him marked Exhibits Nos 2 and 3
respectively - the property described in said Exhibits and in the proceedings in this case is the
same of which John Farguhar died seized - That it will be to the advantage of all parties
interested that said real estate be sold and the proceeds disposed of for the benefit of and
according to the rights of the parties interested - that the tract of land is small and the
income therefrom will be barely sufficient for the support of the widow during her life -
that she would not have the means to keep the House in repair and the lands in good
order - that the House and land would necessarily depreciate in value -


William Ogborn, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainant, being

and herewith returned, deposes and says -


To the first Interrogatory, That he knows all the parties to this Suit and has known them
