Therefore, it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Jesse, recover against the said Alexander A. as well the sum of fifteen hundred dollars current money, his damages aforesaid, in form aforesaid, confessed to be sustained by reason of the nonperformance of the promise and assumption aforesaid, as also the sum of six dollars & eighty six and two thirds cents, by the Court hereunto the said Jesse on his account adjudged for his costs and charges by him about his suit, in this behalf laid out and expended, and the said Alexander A. in mercy &c. >

Memorandum

Judgment rendered in this Cause on the 30th day of October in the year of our Lord, One thousand Eight hundred and fifty eight for the damages laid in the Declaration and costs of suit: the said damages to be released on the payment of the sum of Eight hundred and twenty eight dollars and thirteen cents with interest thereon from the 30th day of October 1858. >
