D. 1858 (or last renewal) for fourteen hundred and ten dollars, payable to John H. Williams Cashier or order negotiable and payable sixty days after date, at the Frederick County Bank, in which Daniel Heafanner and Jacob Heafanner are indorsers, also the said Young hath obtained a loan at the Frederick Town Savings Institution of seven hundred dollars for which he executed a note of hand, on or about the 12th day of May A. D. 1858 (last renewal) payable four months after date, and obtained Henry Heafanner and Daniel Heafanner as indorsers or security, also the said Young executed a note of hand bearing date the 13th day of October A. D. 1857 for one hundred dollars payable one year after date to John H. Williams or order, with interest from date in which Henry Heafanner is security, also the said Young hath executed his note of hand for two hundred and twelve dollars, bearing date the 25th day of January 1858, and payable to Henry Cotte or order (interest from date) twelve months or one year after date, and the said Henry Heafanner is security in said note, also the said Young hath executed a note of hand forty one dollars, bearing date the 13th day of June A. D. 1858, payable to Henry Heafanner or order sixty days after date with interest, and also, the said Young hath executed a note of hand to George Heafanner or order for three hundred dollars bearing date eleventh day of April 1854, and payable six months after date, with interest from date, and also a note of hand, calling for three three hundred and fifty dollars, bearing date the first day of April A. D. 1856, and payable one year after date, with interest from date to John W. Rensberg or order, on which Jacob Heafanner is security.

Now this Indenture witnesseth that for the foregoing consideration, the said Peter Young of S. hath granted unto the said Hanson Rensberg, Samuel Jones, Henry Heafanner, Daniel Heafanner, Jacob Heafanner and Geo. Heafanner, all the following real and personal property viz: the tract or part of a tract of land, conveyed to the said Young by a certain John Heafanner sometime in or about the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, for thirty two and a half acres of land more or less, with the Mill thereon and all other buildings, and all the following household and kitchen furniture viz: seven tables, one corner cupboard, two drawers or bureaus, six stoves, one safe, about thirty four yards Carpeting, one yard of a superior quality of Carpeting, fine looking glasses, one side board, six beds, bedsteads and bedding, twenty one chairs, one mantle clock, two chests, two stands, six window blinds and stain rods, one copper kettle, two iron kettles, also one carriage and harness, one, one horse spring wagon, one sleigh one wheat fan, a lot much poplar boards, a lot of hay, about seven tons, one cider mill and trough one turning lathe, the one half of a field of corn now growing supposed to be four acres, about twenty bushels of wheat in straw and unthreshed one black horse, two cows, one heifer and calf, twenty eight head of hogs. - Provided, that if the said Peter Young (of S.) shall pay on or before the 21st day of August 1860. to the several parties entitled thereto, so as effectually to keep the party to whom he hath executed, their presents from all loss, costs or charges then this mortgage shall be null and void.
