Whereas the said Peter Williard, Henry Heafamer and Samuel Jones, were on the 27th day of December 1859 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County and by virtue of decree thereof as a Court of Equity appointed Trustees to sell the Mill property and land attached of Peter Young (of S) of Frederick County which is fully described in the Bill and proceedings in the Equity Case No 2879 Equity in said Court, for the purpose of paying and satisfying certain mortgages. -

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Peter Williard, Henry Heafamer, Samuel Jones do and shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in them as Trustees aforesaid by the said decree or that may be reposed in them by any future decree or order in the premises then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law. -
