

- allowing 2° for East variation South 43 deg East 11 1/2 perches to a stone North 66 deg East 7 perches to a stone, North 47 deg East 13 perches to a stone, South 88 1/2 deg East 10 perches to a stone, South 82 deg East 13 perches to a stone, North 88 deg East 22 3/4 perches to a stone then by a line of division now located, North 3/4 of a degree East one perch to the end of the sixth line of a deed from John Baker and Mary Baker his wife to John Archer dated on the 27th day of July 1859 and with said sixth line reversed North 3/4 of a degree East 16 perches to the beginning thereof, then by line of division now located North 84 3/4 deg West 4 1/10 pt to a stone, North 25 deg West 25 perches to a stone, North one degree East 7 1/10 perches to a stone North 79 1/2 deg West 33 9/10 perches to a stone, South 11 1/4 deg West 72 1/2 perches intersecting the 5th line of aforesaid deed from Harriet M. James to John Baker and with said line allowing 2 1/2° for East variation South 41 1/2 deg East 33 perches to a stone, still with said deed correcting the course and distance to correspond with stone formerly planted South 4 1/2 deg West 5 perches to a stone, North 87 1/2 deg West 24 perches to the beginning containing 3 1/2 acres and 30 square perches of land in fee simple

 At the request of Henry Gilbert the following deed is recorded the 30th day of June 1840.

This indenture made this 27th day of May in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty, between S. Frederick Alexander Rosind his wife of Frederick County in the State Maryland of the one part and Henry Gilbert of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of sixty two dollars current money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Henry Gilbert, before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said parties of the first part (both hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Henry Gilbert his heirs and assigns all following described piece or parcel of land lying in the County aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called 'Poles Industry' beginning at a marked white oak tree standing at the end of 247 perches on the 25th line of the whole tract and running thence with the outlines thereof North 39 deg West 42 3/4 perches to a stone, South 30 deg East 15 1/2 perches to a stone then North 32 deg West 37 1/2 perches to a stone, South 46 3/4 deg West 2 3/4 perches to a stone, South 27 1/2 deg East 12 3/8 perches to a stone South 13 3/4 deg West 21 3/4 perches to marked poplar, South 39 1/4 deg East 16 perches to a stone South
