At the request of Henry Gilbert the following deed was recorded October 28<sup>th</sup> 1857.

This Indenture made this seventh day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven by John Baker and Mary Baker his wife of Frederick County Maryland, witnesses that in consideration of thirty four dollars and seventy five cents the said John Baker and Mary Baker his wife, do grant unto Henry Gilbert of said County and State, part of that part of a tract of land called 'The Resurvey on Point Lookout', situated, lying and being in Frederick County Maryland, which was conveyed by Harriet & James to John Baker by deed on the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 1854. Beginning for said part at a stone planted at the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> line of aforesaid deed and running with it the four following courses with a correction to correspond with former running South 61 1/2 deg West 32 perches to a stone, South 16 3/4 deg East 7 7/10 perches to the beginning of the meadow land laid off for Mary Cunge and with said land the two following courses allowing 2<sup>o</sup> for variation North 77 deg East 8 perches, South 80 deg East 10 perches, then by a line of division now located, North 23 1/2 deg East 3 3/4 perches to the place of beginning containing one and a half acres and thirty eight square perches of land in fee simple.
